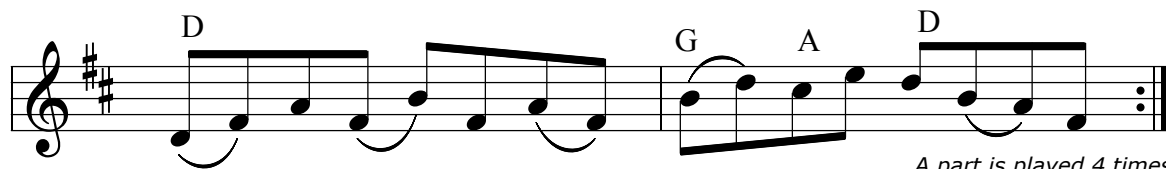
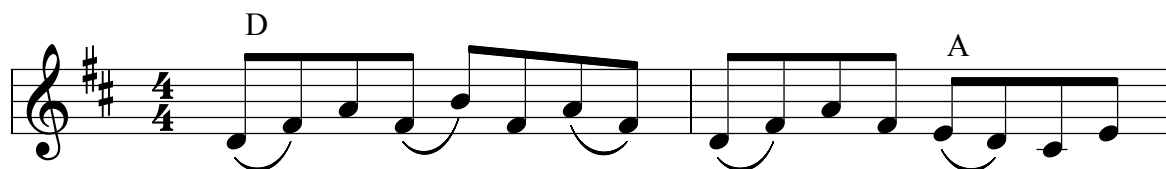
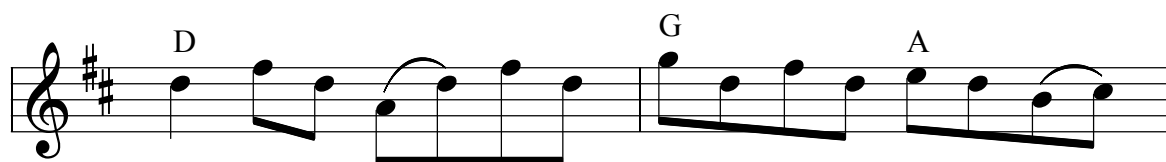


The Doon Reel

Callaghan was the uncle of fiddler Pádraig O'Keeffe, who absorbed the older man's repertoire and called them "Doon reels." The village of Doon is near Kiskeam, County Cork (also called Doonasleen), and is the birth place as well of O'Keeffe's mother Margaret Callaghan, who played the concertina and probably the fiddle.
