Garrett Barry 1847-1899 was an influential piper from Inagh County Clare. He was permanently blinded by malnutrition and sickness as a result of the Great Famine. He died in the Ennistymon Poor House but during his life as an uilleann piper he was successful supporting himself among the farming communities of West Clare.
